BUSINESS MAJORS

Business majors are comprehensive majors that complete the graduation requirements without a minor. Even so, some of the majors have sufficient electives to complete a minor or a mix of courses that match the student's vocational interests. The Business Education major is on a separate degree sheet because of its unique requirements. Students can complete a double major in business by completing the core requirements (excluding electives) of each major. Combining a business major with a major in another discipline will result in two degrees and requires a minimum of at least 154 credit hours.

To maximize this degree completion, JRLC students could take a BBA degree class each semester on the EU campus should GPA and schedules allow.
